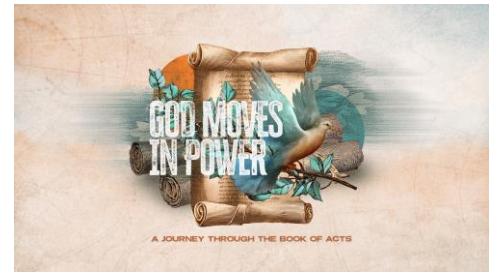

God Moves in Power Through the Gospel



Overview

The sermon series “God Moves in Power” is a journey through the book of Acts, where we witness the Holy Spirit at work through prayer, the gospel, the Church, and ordinary people. As we explore the story of the early church, we’ll discover that the same God who moved powerfully then is still moving today. This series will challenge and encourage us to live with bold faith, expectant prayer, and a willingness to join God’s ongoing mission in the world. The story of Acts is far from over and we’re invited to be a part of it. (Note: This series will explore the book of Acts thematically rather than going through it chapter by chapter or verse-by-verse.)

This Week’s Reading

God moves through prayer. God also moves through the proclamation of his gospel—the message that “Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared” to many (1 Corinthians 15:3-5). How do the passages below show the centrality of God’s gospel?

- Acts 2:1-41
- Luke 24:44-49
- 1 Corinthians 15:1-8
- Romans 1:16-17

As you read, ask yourself

- What do these chapters teach me about who God is (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit)?
- What do they teach me about humanity and the Church?
- What do they teach or reveal about me personally?
